



Ransom J. "Jerry" Gibson

January 16, 1947 - October 15, 2019

Ransom J. "Jerry" Gibson, age 72 years, a resident of Elkins, passed away Tuesday, October 15, 2019 in the Ruby Memorial Hospital at Morgantown. Jerry was born January 16, 1947 at Kingsport, TN, the only child of the late Ransom and Dorothy L. Cross Gibson. On December 24, 2002, he was married to Anita Johnston, who survives. Also surviving are two sons, Timothy Gibson and wife Amber, Kevin Shreve; one daughter, Angela Gibson, all of Elkins, five grandchildren, Lexi and Gabriel Gibson, Sara, Katherine and Nathan Briggs and three great grandchildren. Jerry was a Veteran of the United States Army having served in Vietnam. He came to Elkins as an Army Recruiter and made Elkins his permanent residence after his military service. For many years, Jerry was the DJ at Friar Tucks; he also worked in real estate and eventually owned and operated cable Channel 3 located at Beverly. He recorded many events over the years including the Mountain State Forest Festival Grand Feature Parade. He loved to read books, including the Bible and enjoyed listening to all genres of music. Jerry was a protestant by faith.

Burial will be private.

A Memorial Service will be held at a later date.

“ I’ve been thinking a lot about this and trying to gather my thoughts surrounding the passing of my friend Jerry Gibson. To many he was the guy that spun records all those years ago for their Saturdays night out. He was a fixture at Friar Tucks and the Beverly Fire Hall dances and the American Legion dances. He seemed to know everyone and everyone seemed to know him. Jerry was a local figure that was everywhere. In the very early 1980s Jerry and I met and quickly struck a friendship. Jerry would take me under his wing and teach me the craft of the DJ at those local hang outs. Believe it or not it is a craft. There was rhyme and reason (as he taught me) to what was played and when it was to be played. Jerry helped me get started and soon I was doing the same. I had a lot of fun in those days of my youth and I look back fondly at those times, and the people I got to know. However, the times spinning records was second in my mind to the friendship I made with Jerry. He and I would have long talks about everything in life many times over a home cooked meal at his house with his family. He had one of the best and most extensive record and recording collections I have ever seen numbering in the thousands. I was in awe! He would share his experiences in Vietnam and times growing up in rural Tennessee. Many of our conversations however, seemed to always revert to God and the Bible. Jerry had questions and he was seeking God for the answers. Jerry loved reading the Bible and I remember in those days having long conversations with him about God and one of his favorite books Ecclesiastes. It is the writings of the great King Solomon and his discovery that “life is a vapor”(life is short), and that “everything is vanity” (prideful self serving). A few years later I drifted away from the night life and became a police officer. Jerry and I remained close friends and would still meet from time to time for lunch. When I married my wife, Jerry called me and said he wanted to make a gift to us by video taping our wedding. That was so like him! When I think of Jerry, I will always think of a man that truly loved doing things for others! After I retired at the police department 25 years later, I went to work at another job downtown. I looked up one day and there was Jerry! Going to the post office he would stop and talk with me every few days. My last conversation with Jerry was just last weekend when I called him at home. When I came back from my vacation this past week I learned of Jerry’s passing. It had happened on my birthday. A lot of solemn thoughts in these past days have filled my mind about all those years ago and a man I will always call “friend”. I know where my friend went when he died. He knew Christ! I will see him again one day. To his wife Anita, his children Angie, Tim, and Kevin, I wish to extend my deepest condolences.
